REQUIRED TEXTS:	None. All music will be provided by the UNL School of Music. All students will maintain their individual folders of music at a professional standard and are responsible for replacing missing music. If music is lost, grades will be held until the cost of replacing the music is recovered.
REQUIRED MATERIALS:	All materials necessary for a professional rehearsal environment: Saxophone: all doubles (if available) Trumpet: Cup, Harmon, Bucket and Plunger Mutes; Flügelhorn (if available) Trombone: Cup, Bucket, and Plunger Mute Guitar: All effects and amplifier Bass: Acoustic bass, electric bass, and amplifier Drums: Kit and available auxiliary percussion

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Development of large jazz ensemble performance skills and concert preparation at the professional level.
- Development of improvisation skills and pedagogy

COURSE PROCEDURES

This ensemble will rehearse a minimum of twice per week with the professor or graduate assistant. Additional rehearsals may be scheduled as needed. All sections will be responsible for regular sectional rehearsals to be conducted outside of the Monday/Wednesday rehearsal times. The lead player or graduate assistant will conduct these sectionals.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance at all rehearsals is mandatory. Any improperly documented absence will result in an F for that week. Acceptable documents are: medical notes, court notes, etc. Absence with less than 24 hours notice to the professor and all ensemble musicians will result in an F for that week.

Each ensemble member is allowed one excused absence per semester **except for the two rehearsals prior to a performance. Unless the circumstances are dire, absence from either of the two rehearsals immediately prior to a concert will result in an F for the course and dismissal from the ensemble.** All absences must be cleared with the professor and the student must arrange an acceptable substitute.
